

**2011 CANNING SHOW - INFORMATION TO STALL HOLDERS  
Friday 4 & Saturday 5 November 2011**

**GATES OPEN:**

5pm to 10pm Friday 4 November, 9am to 10pm Saturday 5 November

**ALLOCATION OF STALL SITES:**

Applications for Ground Space and Stall Sites will close on Friday 30 September, 2011 and must be in the hands of the Executive Officer at the Society Office by 5 pm on that date. Stall sites will be allocated, as far as possible, to meet the preferred location nominated on the Application Form, but an alternative site may be allocated. Consideration will be given to previous stall holders.

Care will be taken to avoid similar type stalls being located close to one another, but as craft, gift and novelty stalls can often sell the same stock, this may not always be possible. The decision of the Executive Officer or Ground Steward will be final.

All stall holders will receive notification of the acceptance or otherwise of their application.

Late applications for a Stall Site cannot be guaranteed. Enquiries for vacant sites can be made to the Executive Officer, Phone 9451 1820 but will not be allocated until the application and fee is received and accepted.

**SETTING UP:**

All display/stall holders are required to set up and ready for operation by 4.30pm Friday and 8.30am Saturday. No vehicles will be allowed to enter the show grounds after 4pm Friday and must be removed by 4.30pm and 8am Saturday and must be removed by 8.30am. There are no exceptions. Stalls may be set up from 8am on Friday 4 November.

Stalls located on paved areas are not suited for pegs into the ground and must be free standing. Stall holders on grassed areas are required to ensure stalls are adequately secured to the ground and pegs and ropes are positioned to prevent an obstruction or hazard to persons. Stalls left over night are at the stall holders own risk.

Restocking of stalls can be made provided vehicles are moved from the show grounds by 4.30pm Friday and 8.30am Saturday.

**ALL STALLS MUST REMAIN IN OPERATION ON THE SHOW GROUNDS ON FRIDAY EVENING TO 9PM AND ALL DAY SATURDAY TO 9PM.**

**STALL FURNITURE:**

Stall holders must provide their own tables, trestles, chairs, stands and display equipment.

**POWER SUPPLY:**

Power points are available on the grounds for connection to stalls. Stall holders are required to provide adequate power leads and adaptors. Users of large quantities of power cannot be guaranteed electric power.

**PARKING:**

There is NO PARKING for vehicles inside the Show Grounds. All vehicles must be moved outside the grounds half an hour before the opening times. There is ample areas for public free parking close to the show grounds. Any vehicle left in the show grounds in restricted times will be towed.

**REMOVAL OF STALLS:**

The closing time for the Canning Show on Friday and Saturday evening will be 10pm. There will be a programme of entertainment on the grounds and side shows to closing time. Exhibition halls will close at 9pm. Fireworks will commence on Friday at 9pm.

Stalls must remain open until at least 9pm on both Friday and Saturday, and may continue operating to the closing time. Vehicle gates will not be opened until 9.30pm. All care must be taken to avoid public obstruction.

**STALL PASSES:**

Stall persons will not require passes if entering the show grounds before 4.30pm Friday and 8.30am Saturday. A limit of one pass per metre frontage of each stall per day will be issued with each application (ie 4 metres frontage = 8 passes for 2 days) A maximum of up to 15 passes may be issued. Special pass arrangements can be made with the Executive Officer.
